String Quartet

Spend a happy Saturday stitching scrappy strings and strips – make several different blocks using this simple traditional, but still modern, technique. Transform the blocks into bags, cushions etc after class.

Requirements

- 2 fat quarters of background – they could be the same, or similar
- Scraps, strips and strings – min.size 1 x 3 inches; if you don't have any* then bring about 6 fat quarters to cut up.
- Paper scissors
- Pencil and/or black felt pen
- Fabric scissors

*Chris's ever-expanding scrap bag(s) will be available for you to use, cut into, take away . . .

Plus the usual list, which is –

- Sewing machine in good working order, 2 pre-wound bobbins, a new needle and spares, handbook and all accessories
- Cotton sewing thread of your choice in a neutral colour eg dark cream, pale grey
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat – please check your blade before class and replace with new if required
- A few pins
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric markers of your choice
- Scissors for snipping threads
- Travel iron and pressing pad – optional (PAT certificate required)
- Extension cable – optional (PAT certificate required)
